June, Pam and Steve’s commitment to Seguin flows from their deeply held belief in Seguin’s mission: To integrate, enrich and empower people with disabilities and other special needs, enabling them to be productive, valued members of society. Their dedication to Seguin, however, started long before their successful bowling parties.

Thirteen years ago, Pam Kawohl, organized a group of her co-workers from the McDonald’s Corporation to support Seguin Services as their chosen community service. Initially, they adopted a Foster Care family donating Christmas presents and dinners, Easter gifts and Thanksgiving dinners. Then they contributed “Back to School” supplies as well as Toys for Tots gifts to children served in Seguin’s foster care program.

During the past eight years, through Pam’s outstanding leadership and skill, McDonald’s volunteers have refurbished and beautified the yards and exteriors of several Seguin group homes. They have

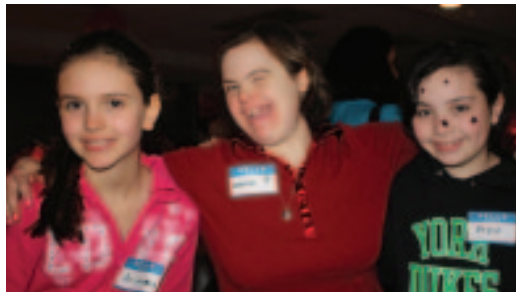

Jobs75 Initiative:

Seguin Partners with Area Agencies To Find Jobs for People with Disabilities

Individuals across the nation and especially Illinois have suffered from continuing economic uncertainty and mass unemployment. The unemployment rate for persons with disabilities of all types exceeds 70%, and for individuals with intellectual disabilities the rate is even higher. To address this paramount issue, Seguin Services has joined hands with other area service agencies in establishing a major new project to secure employment for the people we serve: the Jobs75 Initiative.

The Chicago-based Coleman Foundation has provided major funding The Jobs75 Initiative, which constitutes a key component of the Coleman-sponsored Intersect for Ability Network. Seguin serves as the project's lead agency in collaboration with Misericordia, Easter Seals, Countryside Association, PACTT, Park Lawn and Clearbrook. The goal for the project is simple: place 75 individuals with developmental disabilities in full-time or part-time jobs throughout metropolitan Chicago over the next year.

Intersect agencies are seeking employers large and small, from major corporations to local businesses, who are willing to be partners in the Jobs75 Initiative. Thus far a few employers have

already hired project participants, while some have also joined as Advisory Council members to assist with the initiative. Businesses who employ persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities receive a wonderful return on their investment. They are provided with capable workers who are reliable, hard-working, competent, and enthusiastic, and thereby help the business meet their bottom lines.

In addition, partner agencies provide on-site job coaching for participants to ensure that they fully understand the job requirements and are able to meet those responsibilities. Project staff will also facilitate or directly provide special training to their employees without disabilities on working with people with cognitive impairments and other disabilities.

Beyond offering a strong labor pool for employers, the Jobs75 Initiative gives individuals with disabilities the chance to increase their self-esteem and to be more self-sufficient. They become productive members of their community. Ultimately the benefits to the employers combined with the positive outcomes for people with disabilities make this project a "win-win" for all involved!

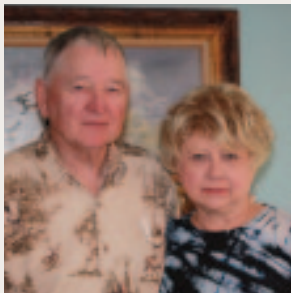
"Stay Up Late"

These parties give participants an opportunity to engage people with and without disabilities in typical community settings, enjoying music, dance, refreshments and repartee. These events have taken place at a variety of venues, most recently at Seguin's Betty Scheck Senior Center with music provided by disc jockey Rick Storto. Seguin Receives Wonderful Planned Charitable Gift

Before the recent winter holidays Anthony & Estelle Nakroshis asked themselves—how could they provide for their son Tony Jo and the agency that had served him so well for 25 years? Tony and Estelle's answer: Give Seguin a fully paid life insurance policy. This incredible gift, combined with a loan from



United Cerebral Palsy of Greater Chicago, a bequest from the estate of Dolores Nowicki, and the generosity of additional donors provides the means for Seguin to build a new specially-designed state-of-the-art residential group home in Lombard for individuals with developmental disabilities who have multiple needs. This home should be completed later this fall. Seguin will bestow its highest recognition to Tony and Estelle Nakroshis by naming this new home in their honor.

Tony & Estelle learned early in Estelle's pregnancy that their son T.J. would have severe disabilities. Estelle contracted German measles after T.J. was conceived. This left T.J. with multiple disabilities including loss of sight and hearing, a heart condition and autism. The Nakroshis' proceeded to advocate for people with special needs with a loving spirit and an attitude to serve their son the best way they could.

Through the years, they worked extra jobs to pay for doctor visits, physical therapy, and schooling, and sought special educational opportunities for their son. They also strongly advocated for him and all individuals throughout Illinois who are deaf, blind or have a developmental disability. Tony showed his leadership by doggedly asking then Governor Thompson for assistance for families. He secured commitment from State legislators to sponsor a bill to create a school for the deaf and blind, subsequently founded as the Phillip J. Rock Center. Tony also led as the Administrative Dean at Reavis High School in District 220 in Burbank, Illinois. He worked to mainstream children with disabilities, adapting the school building to render it accessible even before federal and state mandates required this action. Meanwhile, Estelle went back to school to ensure she was certified to teach special needs children. Throughout their lives, both Tony & Estelle have worked tirelessly to provide for their son and furnish the essential needs of this vulnerable population.

Today, they continue their life's work by providing for their son and those like him who have multiple disabilities. Their hearts have led them to leave a lasting gift to Seguin. Seguin is humbled and extremely grateful for the Nakroshis' thoughtful generosity.

As he was making the transition from high school to adult services, Chris was befriended by Andrew P. in one of his Seguin classrooms.
