Volunteer opportunities in community venues

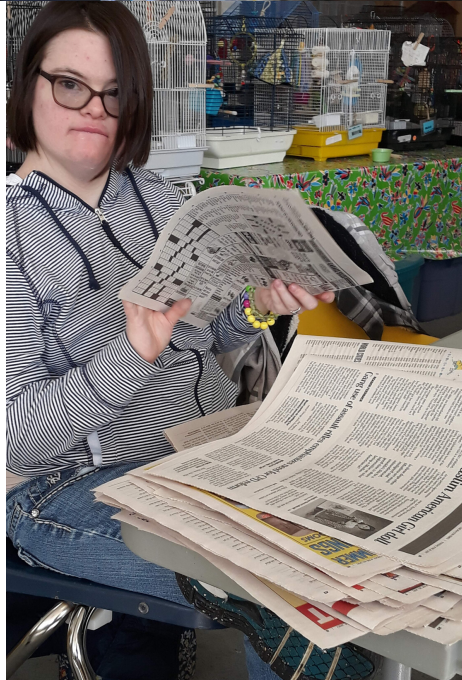
