

## The UCP Seguin Social Recreation Program is divided into three types of activities/events:



**Group Events** are activities voted on by members, planned and organized by the club's staff, and attended by three or more members. Activities and events include, but are not limited to crafting, mock casino nights, sip & paint parties, game nights, various outdoor outings, movie nights, holiday activities, Social Fridays, karaoke, traveling and much more.



**Buddy Outings** are smaller, individualized, member-led outings for two to three people. Club members are encouraged to organize and plan activities with their favorite "buddy/buddies" or meet someone new. Members plan their outings according to their interests and work with the Social Rec staff to ensure a successful buddy outing.



**The UCP Seguin Chargers** are the Paralympic Boccia team organized by Social Rec. The team consists of eight athletes, all of whom are in wheelchairs and have cerebral palsy or a similar disability.

The Chargers have competed in boccia, a precision ball sport, across the country as well as internationally. A recent meet in Iowa earned the team multiple bronze, silver, and gold medals. Next up is a competition in California!

UCP Seguin dedicated The Behrman House, a home in Country Club Hills in their honor. This home serves as a testament to Paul, Andrew and the entire Behrman family's continued advocacy and inspiring dedication to creating opportunities for people with disabilities.



### THE BALZARINI HOUSE 134 East Avenue Oak Park

The most important things in life are best when shared with those we love — whether it be a place, a person, or a passion. For the Balzarini family, UCP Seguin has provided an opportunity to combine their shared commitment to helping people with disabilities lead fulfilling lives, proving that a family that volunteers together stays together. While he has excelled in all of his jobs, he wanted a career. Jonathan took the initiative to complete certification training to be a security guard. Jonathan is an across-the-board, certified PROFESSIONAL – a true testament to his initiative and unparalleled determination to succeed.

### Peter Continues to Overcome ...with Help From UCP Seguin's Children's Foster Program

In September 2018, Peter came to live with his devoted foster mom Marcy. At 22 months old and weighing only 10 pounds, Peter had been diagnosed with "Failure to Thrive", cerebral palsy, and other challenges. He was very small and under-developed; he was not walking, talking, or eating...he was barely surviving. Foster Mom Marcy said she prayed to God for the strength to take care of him and all of his needs. Peter

saw at least 10 doctors, specialists, and therapists...often having two or three appointments weekly. He received intensive physical, occupational, and speech therapy services at Shirley Ryan Ability Lab as well as at home.

The UCP Seguin Children's Foster Care team leapt into action to support Marcy and Peter in every way. Nursing staff ensured Marcy and her family on his nutritional, healthcare, and therapeutic supports and accompanied them to doctor's appointments. Case Managers were on-call 24/7 to make sure Peter received everything required for him to continue to thrive and grow. They also made sure certain Peter was able to maintain a relationship with his biological siblings.

Almost five years later, Peter has grown and flourished. At age three he

started preschool, and at age five he took another major step by entering kindergarten. Marcy is confident that Peter will excel in school, just as he has already overcome the countless other challenges in his young life. Peter has a huge personality that lights up the day of everyone he meets, and his vocabulary is, well, out of this world. He is just a very lovable, affectionate, and funny kid who loves music, basketball, and the piano.

Peter's amazing progress is a testament to his fortitude, as well as the nurturing love, support, advocacy, and encouragement he receives from Marcy and his extended foster family.

# Elected Leaders Secure Major Federal Grant for UCP Seguin

Sponsorship by Congressman Garcia and Senator Durbin Nets \$975,000 in Capital Funding

UCP Seguin’s stakeholders are fortunate to be represented by many elected officials who see themselves as “public servants”, including Congressman Jesus “Chuy” Garcia of the 4th District of Illinois and U.S. Senator Richard Durbin of Illinois. Through their sponsorship and successful advocacy with the FY2022 federal budget, Congressman Garcia and Senator Durbin were able to secure a \$975,000 Community Project Funding/ Congressionally Directed Spending grant to help UCP Seguin deliver on its mission to people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD).

This grant will cover costs for Community Day Services site capital improvements, including major and much-needed renovations on UCP Seguin’s Carr Center, our headquarters and largest training center in Cicero. These dollars help ensure that we have functional, accessible, safe, and energy-efficient environments for the people with IDD we serve.

As noted by Joseph Mengoni, UCP Seguin President/ CEO, “These capital funds allow us to devote our other precious funding resources to where they can be best utilized – to direct services to people with developmental disabilities, and to paying our staff the wages they deserve. This federal funding

will create essential jobs for people in construction trades as well.”

Due to their stalwart advocacy on behalf of UCP Seguin and persons served, at its mid-April 2023 “The BIG Event”, UCP Seguin is bestowing its prestigious President’s Award to both Congressman Garcia and Senator Durbin.

Thanks to Congressman Garcia’s and Senator Durbin’s invaluable support, UCP Seguin can be an economic engine for Cicero and surrounding communities, while fulfilling our mission: life without limits for people with disabilities.

## UCP Seguin earns 5<sup>th</sup> Consecutive 3-year Accreditation from Praesidium, Inc.
